Tenure

terminal degree

evidence of teaching effectiveness, as demonstrated by

-classroom observation by tenured departmental faculty and chair

-student evaluation

scholarly contribution and its likely continuance

some level of university service

departmental collegiality

Promotion

to associate professor

-continued teaching effectiveness (as discussed above)

-scholarly contribution, including at least two articles and two presentations/book reviews/grants, or some combination thereof, as determined to be sufficient by tenured departmental faculty and the chair

-continued service contributions

to full professor

-continued teaching effectiveness (as discussed above)

-scholarly contribution, including the publication of a book, five articles, five presentations, or some combination thereof, as determined to be sufficient by tenured departmental faculty and the chair
