

2. 1981-Mai. Suite Réponse; Note TOR de 101 á 118. Réunion Bruxelles. [2. May 1981. Responses continued; Notes TOR from 101 to 118. Brussels Meeting.] (Green Box 5)

Group I: Two folders with comments and suggestions about a draft of the Rule in English and Italian.

Group II: A list of congregations who responded to the second consultation on a draft of the Rule and completed questionnaires about each chapter in the draft of the Rule with comments and suggestions in Spanish, German, Dutch, Italian, French, English, and Portuguese. Many of the questionnaires have additional comments attached to them, and signatures of members of the congregation. Each document has a handwritten number from 101-178 at the top right hand corner, which corresponds to the congregation who authored the document (see list in Green Box 7). A number of the congregations did not use the questionnaire, but provided comments and suggestions about the draft of the Rule. Congregation 136 worked with congregations 73 and 93-97 during weekends of reflection. The answers to their questionnaires may have similar thoughts and rationales, but also may reflect differences in opinion. Congregation 136 has an explanation letter before its comments about the congregations’ reflection meetings and the draft of the Rule. Documents are handwritten and/or in original and reproduced typescript.
