

## **Retiree definition and benefits 2020**

A retiree from St. Bonaventure University is someone who meets all of the following criteria:

- Has age plus service equal to 70 years or more
- Intends to retire from the full-time work force rather than leave employment for another position elsewhere.
- Is leaving St. Bonaventure under honorable circumstances (the faculty or staff member was not terminated or asked to resign).

### **Benefits available to retirees**

- Faculty or staff level continued library access.
- Retiree ID card. Must turn in old ID card and receive new Retiree ID.
- Free parking (must contact Security upon retirement to receive retiree parking pass and renew every two years thereafter).
- Access to the Richter Center for both retiree and spouse.
- Continued use of SBU email account (upon request); no system/IT access
- Retiring faculty may retain their office space until two weeks before the start of the next academic semester (either spring or fall) after retirement. Additional note: Deans have the discretion to assign office space to adjunct faculty and/or retired faculty if the space is available.
- Reduced cost/free access to University cultural and sporting events except men's basketball games (with ID card).
- University Bookstore discounts with ID card.
- Free non- credit auditing of any SBU graduate or undergraduate courses for retiree and spouse (with instructor permission).
- Invitation to annual University Christmas party.
